Germany e-invoicing mandate

- Germany will gradually transform towards a more regulated e-invoicing model
- B2G e-invoicing has been mandatory since 2020
- B2B e-invoicing mandate will be to fully effective from the 1st of January 2028 onwards
- Rollout will be gradual starting 1st January 2025
- Mandate is following the EN 16931 standard from the European Committee for Standardization (CEN) and ViDA initiative
- Germany e-invoicing model will remain "postaudit", there will be no government platform to control the e-invoice flows nor tax processes for now

Mandate timelines



Key impact on businesses

- Formats will change to EN 16931 standard
 - XRechnung is the official format
 - Peppol BIS and ZUGFeRD are also supported
- Companies must establish capability to receive EN standard e-invoices 1st of January 2025 onwards
- Issuing paper invoices will not be allowed after transition period (milestones on 1st of January 2027 and 2028)
- During transition period business partners can agree now to exchange invoices based on bilateral agreements as long as general timelines are followed
- Suppliers do not need buyer consent anymore to send e-invoices if invoices are meeting EN 16931 standard


Additional impacts and details

- Long transition period requires flexibility from systems and AP process - capability to handle different formats is needed.
- EDI / point-to-point connections are allowed going forward but need to move to EN compliant formats.
- Invoices via email as PDF format will continue since ZUGFeRD is EN compliant.
- Cross border invoicing will not be impacted various electronic formats, regular PDF via email and paper still continues and need to be supported.
- B2G e-invoicing will remain as is.
- Tax reporting will not change at this point but ViDA initiative will take a stand on that ~2030.



Solution for invoice sending



Message exchange phases:

- 1) Receive invoice data (any format)
- 2) Convert to OC format and further into required EN 16931 compliant format
- 3) Deliver invoices to recipient
 - As e-invoices (interoperability network / Peppol) or EDI (point-to-point)
 - Email (ZUGFeRD) or other formats for cross border
 - Printing (until deadline in DE) and cross border
- 4) Archive (add-on service)

Data is stored in Track and Trace (invoice and related details/documents) 90 days.



Solution for invoice receiving

Message exchange phases:

- 1) Receive invoices from senders
 - As e-invoices (interoperability network / Peppol) or EDI (point-topoint)
 - Email (until deadline except ZUGFeRD)
 - Digitizing (until deadline) and cross border
- 2) Convert to OC format and further into customer format
- 3) Deliver to receiver
- 4) Archive (add-on service)

Data is stored in Track and Trace for 90 days.

Commonly asked questions (1)

What happens January 2025?

All companies need to have capability to receive EN compliant e-invoices.

What happens January 2027?

Companies with revenue exceeding 800k EUR must send only EN compliant e-invoices.

What happens January 2028?

All companies must send only EN compliant e-invoices.

What does EN 16931 compliance mean?

Invoices must follow a set of standardized formats, data syntaxes, and semantics. These standards ensure that e-invoices are structured consistently, making them easier to process, exchange, and reconcile across different systems and organizations.

Where can I get details on EN 16931?

EN 16931 compliance (europa.eu)

Do I need to change something in my ERP?

Most likely yes. Both for receiving and sending invoices. Your ERP must support the e.g. mandatory data content of invoices.

What role do third-party service providers play in facilitating e-invoicing adoption?

Service provider typically can offer you multi-channel sending/receiving capability to reach all suppliers/customers. Also service provider can/will do format conversions, integrations to back-end systems, business partner onboarding etc.

Do I need to change tax reporting due mandate?

No, not at this point.

Commonly asked questions (2)

Can I start/continue using Peppol?

Yes. Peppol formats are EN compliant already.

If e-invoices are in XML format can there also be visual version e.g. PDF of the invoice?

Yes. Invoices can be visualized either by sender or receiver. Visualization (and other attachments to XML) can also contain additional information required by business processes.

Do I need to agree with my customers when I want to change to e-invoicing format or way how to deliver the invoices?

In practice we recommend at least to inform your customer, in order to ensure successful delivery of invoices.

How can I get as many invoices as e-invoices as soon as possible?

It is good to inform and instruct your suppliers to send e-invoices.

How does the transition to e-invoicing affect small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs)?

All companies must move to e-invoicing. Smaller companies most likely have to update their ERP to have the capability to create EN compliant data and/or purchase this as service.

What are the potential cost savings associated with e-invoicing implementation?

Compared to printing and digitizing savings are big, even bigger when including process automation related benefits. Many companies report 60-80% cost savings after moving to e-invoices.

How does the e-invoicing mandate affect international businesses trading with Germany?

Since all companies will have possibility to exchange invoices electronically the benefits for cross border business are also considerable. Since e-invoice requirements differ to some extent country-by-country, any multi-country company need to adopt to those.
